John Clarke – Rotary Foundation

The Foundation is one the largest private charities in the world. It was established in 1917 and has donated over three billion dollars to sustainable life changing projects. There are 2 streams to the foundation:

- The General Fund where half the donations are returned to the district they came from for the purpose of local projects

- The Polio Fund where all donations go to the End Polio Now project. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation donate \$2 for every \$1 from Rotary. In the last year in Afghanistan, there were 10 cases, in Pakistan cases and in Nigeria there have been no cases since 2016. In Papua New Guinea there were 3 cases this year but these were related to a reaction to the immunisation not the actual disease. The illness can be easily spread which is why it is vital to keep the immunisation project going.

We all drive motor vehicles these days and the motor vehicle industry has change a lot over the years.

When Darrell came to Cooma 50 odd years ago in 1965 to work for Urquhart and Nicholls Motors there were significantly more motor traders than there are today. Darrell’s company were Holden dealers, others sold Datsun’s, Toyotas, Grenville Motors sold VW’s and Land Rovers, there was Cooma Chrysler, a sub-branch for Datsun’s, a Ford dealership and Burke & Churchill who sold Austin’s, Morris and Wozzley’s. Today there are 2 basic dealerships Alpine Ford and Cooma Toyota who deal in most brands of vehicles. How times have changed.
