The hydraulics lab was the design engine of the Snowy Scheme, later put into world service by SMEC. The visit is foreseen to be an enlightening introduction to Damien Kenneally's vocational presentation to the Club on the same evening.

## Invitation

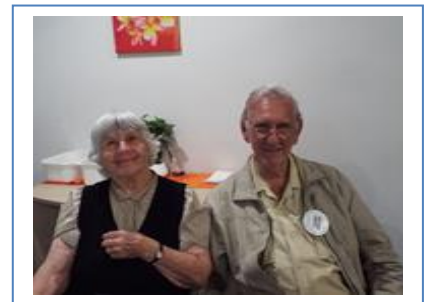
Rotarians are accordingly invited to register for the visit. Then SMEC can make sure they have enough hard hats on the day.

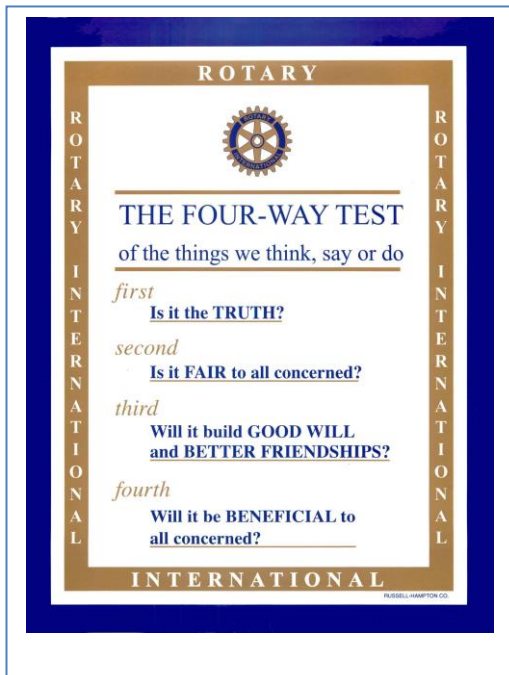
## Hass
