Elaine S – Cooma Rotary Duck Race

For 6 years, we have held our great Cooma Rotary Duck Race in conjunction with the Rotary markets in October. On average there have been 680 ducks sold per year.

Proceeds raised go to local charities. Over the last 3 years, before COVID, proceeds went to Stage 1, Learn to Swim Program for Cooma local junior schools.

The process for organising the duck race is duck tickets and posters are printed in August, in early September books given to Rotary members who wish to sell tickets and a roster is organised for volunteers to sit at stalls at local supermarkets to sell tickets in October.

On the Rotary market day in October, a group of Rotarians and friends, put the sold ducks in the Cooma Creek below the Massie St causeway and the ducks float to the finish line.

Starting now, I ask Rotarians to source donations, goods, services, vouchers etc from local businesses so we have a prize pool in place before the tickets are printed in August. Please provide information back to me by end of July so tickets can be printed.

Sandra – The Community Service committee are looking at a project which will consist of renovating a playground in Wangie Street, East Cooma. There is a call for people to do a letterbox drop on Saturday 3 July advising of the project and seek local resident and neighbourhood interest in the project. If all goes well it is anticipated there will be a community meeting at the playground on Saturday 10 July.

Marco – Following discussion at this week's meeting it has been decided that evening dinner meetings will continue on a fortnightly basis.
